The Second Place Scholarship was our WGA Golf Tournament Funded Scholarship in the amount of \$2,046.00. These funds were raised from our Annual Golf Tournament Golfers at our 2018 Golf Tournament.

The Third Place Scholarship in the amount of \$1,000 was our WGA General Fund Scholarship funded from our General Fund.

Thank you to Ramona Gagner, Development Officer for Tacoma Rescue Mission, who served as our non-industry judge and participated in the awards presentation to our scholarship winners along with our WGA Scholarship Chair, Bernie Thueringer, Pacific Glass, Inc. and WGA President, Bud Henson, Window Tech., Inc. WGA donated \$1,000 to Tacoma Rescue Mission's new Woman's Shelter Project in honor of our judge, Ramona Gagner, as a thank you - \$200 from the WGA general fund, the balance from June Dinner Meeting attendees!
